- The Treasure Valley's only 24/7 shelter for unaccompanied youth ages 9-17
- Emergency shelter and short-term residential care for runaway and homeless youth, as well as on-site therapy to help youth heal and process trauma
- Respite care gives primary caregivers much-needed relief and improves family stability
- Provides strengths-based family and individual counseling, structured education, and life skills classes
- Idaho Youth Ranch Thrift Stores in the Treasure Valley and Hays House are designated Safe Places. The Safe Place program is for young people in need of immediate help and safety. As a collaborative community initiative, Safe Place designates businesses and organizations as Safe Place locations that are trained to connect the youth to Hays House
- 24-hour helpline for kids and families
- 18 beds
